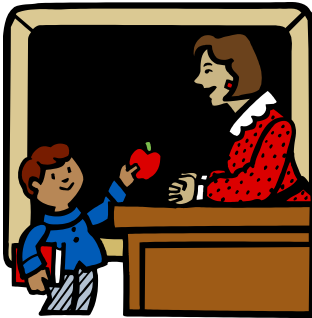

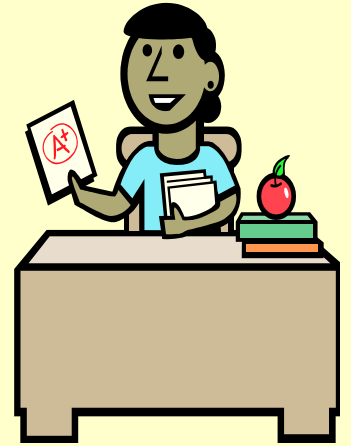
Mrs. Jennifer Mosley
